



MISSION WORKSHOP EIGER WX FIELD JACKET

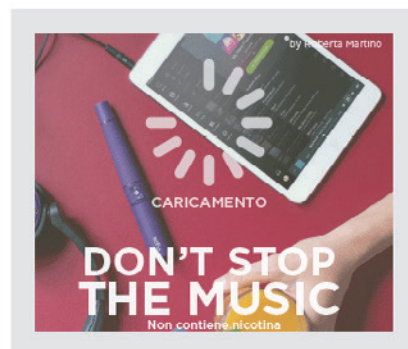
